

Introduced by Treese Council Bill No. R 68-17

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of the Vandiver Drive and Parker Street roundabout improvement project; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of the Vandiver Drive and Parker Street roundabout improvement project was held by the Public Works Department on May 10, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on July 3, 2017. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of the Vandiver Drive and Parker Street roundabout improvement project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City. The improvements proposed include the following:

- Construction of a 140-foot diameter inscribed circle single-lane roundabout;
- Construction of splitter islands;
- Construction of five-foot sidewalks on the southeast and northwest legs of the roundabout;
- Construction of six-foot sidewalks on the southwest and northeast legs of the roundabout;
- Reconstruction of an additional 300-feet of the Vandiver Drive roadway west of the roundabout; and
- Installation of street lighting.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$900,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from 2018 County Road Tax Rebate funds, capital improvement sales tax funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.


