MISSOURI HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION STP-URBAN PROGRAM SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT #2

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is entered into by the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (hereinafter, "Commission") and the City of Columbia (hereinafter, "City").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2013 the Commission and the City previously entered into a STP-Urban Funds Agreement as to public improvements designated as urban roadway improvements, for the improvements of Providence Road including roadway widening, construction of curb and gutter, removing signalized intersection at Rollins, and the installation of signals at Burnam Road and Turner Avenue (hereinafter, "Original Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2015, the Commission and the City previously entered into a STP-Urban Supplemental Agreement (hereinafter, "Supplemental Agreement #1");

WHEREAS, the Commission and the City now desire to revise the Original Agreement and the previous Supplemental Agreement #1 as provided in this Supplemental Agreement #2.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representations contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- (1) <u>REVISION</u>: Paragraph 12 (A) of the Original Agreement is hereby removed and replaced with the following:
 - (12) <u>REIMBURSEMENT</u>: The cost of the contemplated improvements will be borne by the United States Government and by the City as follows:

- (A) Any federal funds for project activities shall only be available for reimbursement of eligible costs which have been incurred by City. Any costs incurred by City prior to authorization from FHWA and notification to proceed from the Commission are **not** reimbursable costs. All federally funded projects are required to have a project end date. Any costs incurred after the project end date are not eligible for reimbursement. The federal share for this project will be 80 percent not to exceed \$2,464,181.99. The calculated federal share for seeking federal reimbursement of participating costs for the herein improvements will be determined by dividing the total federal funds applied to the project by the Any costs for the herein improvements which total participating costs. exceed any federal reimbursement or are not eligible for federal reimbursement shall be the sole responsibility of City. The Commission shall not be responsible for any costs associated with the herein improvement unless specifically identified in this Agreement or subsequent written amendments.
- (2) <u>ORIGINAL AGREEMENT</u>: Except as otherwise modified, amended, or supplemented by this Supplemental Agreement, the Original Agreement and all previous Supplemental Agreements between the parties shall remain in full force and effect and shall extend and apply to this Supplemental Agreement as if fully written in this Supplemental Agreement.
