

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 51-17

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for proposed construction of the Bingham Road and Ridgeley Road PCCE #16 sanitary sewer improvement project; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed construction of the Bingham Road and Ridgeley Road PCCE #16 sanitary sewer improvement project were held on October 24, 2012, March 9, 2015 and October 27, 2016.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on May 15, 2017. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the construction of approximately 3,290 linear feet of gravity sewer, installation of new private service connections and replacement of service laterals for reconnection to the new sewer main, all in accordance with City of Columbia Street and Storm Sewer Specifications and Standards, as part of the Bingham Road and Ridgeley Road PCCE #16 sanitary sewer improvement project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.


SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$1,800,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from sanitary sewer utility funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
