The City Manager's Office has received the following requests for street closure:

(1) Columbia Public Schools/Partners in Education have requested closure of Walnut Street from 7th to 8th Street (in front of courthouse) on May 5, 2005, 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. for a flag ceremony.

(2) The Columbia Multisport Club has requested closure of 6th Street, between Locust and Elm; Elm from 8th to 5th (maybe not that far) on Saturday, April 9, 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for the annual Jay Dix Challenge to Cure walk/run to benefit cancer research.

(3) On behalf of the United Methodist Conference, the Convention and Visitor's Bureau has requested the closure of 9th Street, between Locust and Elm, on Sunday, June 5, 2005, 8:00 p.m. to midnight, for a dance following ordination at the Missouri United Methodist Church.

(4) Stephens College has requested the following street closing to accommodate commencement ceremonies in Silverthorne Arena on Dorsey Street:
a. Close Dorsey Street between Broadway and Bass Street on Saturday, May 7th, from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
b. No parking zone on Dorsey Street between Broadway and Bass Street, Saturday, May 7 from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Emergency services have been notified. The CCA Board met on March 16 and recommend approval of the requests.
