Resolution Authorizing Application for LWCF Grant-Stephens Lake

Park Amphitheater

Summary: The Department of Parks and Recreation has submitted a preliminary grant application to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) for partial funding for the construction of the Stephens Lake Park Amphitheater. Tentative approval has been received for the grant contingent upon DNR receiving a formal resolution from the Columbia City Council authorizing the grant application. Total project cost is estimated at \$45,000 and the grant would provide 45% (\$20,250) of the project. The remaining \$24,750 match will come from the previously designated Park Sales Tax budget for the development of Stephens Lake Park. The proposed LWCF Grant would be used to increase the size, access and electricity needs of the amphitheater stage and to provide additional support features such as security lighting, walkways and landscaping.

<u>Discussion:</u> The Missouri Department of Natural Resources is currently accepting applications for the Land and Water Conservation Fund FY-2007 program. The grant program is a 55% matching program with a maximum project limit of \$30,000 per community. The LWCF is a competitive grant program and provides funding for a wide variety of outdoor recreation projects intended to help communities meet the unmet recreation needs of citizens.

The Department of Parks and Recreation currently has a budget of \$25,000 to finish the amphitheater at Stephens Lake Park. The proposed LWCF Grant would be used to increase the size, access and electricity needs of the amphitheater stage and to provide additional support features such as security lighting, walkways and landscaping. Exact specifications of the stage will be developed through a planning committee of parks and programming staff, community theater groups, and sound/lighting technicians.

Based on a preliminary application by staff, DNR has given tentative approval of the grant contingent upon receipt of a resolution from the City Council authorizing and endorsing the grant application.

<u>Suggested Council Action:</u> Approve the resolution authorizing the grant application to the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program for additional funding of the Stephens Lake Park amphitheater.
