The Columbia Parks and Recreation Department has received several donations for the C.A.R.E. Program in the Department. This ordinance appropriates the funds from the Permanent Park Improvement Fund to the appropriate account for the programs and authorizes the expenditure of the funds.

DISCUSSION:

The Columbia Parks and Recreation Department has received donations from:

<u>Wal-Mart – Broadway store</u>: Wal-Mart provided a \$1,000 donation to the C.A.R.E. Program for the purposes of purchasing supplies and materials for the C.A.R.E. Programs garden program for youth. This includes plants, seeds, fertilizer, garden tools, etc. for the program's garden project.

<u>First Night Columbia, Inc.</u>: First Night donated \$400 to the C.A.R.E. Gallery for the puppets and marionettes used in the First Night celebration this December. The donation allowed the Gallery to purchase materials for the program which are designed and created by C.A.R.E. students involved in the Gallery.

The money from these donations was deposited into the Permanent Park Improvement Fund. This ordinance authorizes the appropriation of these funds from this fund to the C.A.R.E. programs expenditure accounts. The money will be used as requested by the donors.
