A RESOLUTION

authorizing an agreement with the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association for Sports Development Funding under the Tourism Development Program for the MBCA 2007 Clinic.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association for Sports Development Funding under the Tourism Development Program for the MBCA 2007 Clinic. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as fully as if set forth herein verbatim.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2007, by and between the City of Columbia, Missouri (hereinafter "City"), and Missouri Basketball Coaches Association (hereinafter "Contractor").

City and Contractor agree as follows:

1. The Contractor shall provide the services outlined in its proposal for Sports Development Funds for the MBCA 2007 Clinic, as submitted to the City's Convention and Visitors Bureau, a copy of which is on file in that office, at a cost to the City of **\$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand Dollars)** in connection with the performance of the services to be provided under the agreement, the Contractor agrees to comply with all civil rights laws, and further agrees not to discriminate against any individual or segment of the community on the basis of sex, race, color, age, religion, creed, national origin, veteran, disability status or sexual orientation.
2. Contractor agrees that it is responsible for all funds made available to Contractor by this Agreement and further agrees that it will reimburse to the City any funds expended in violation of city, state, or federal law or in violation of this agreement.
3. Contractor agrees that it will make no changes in the approved Project until the changes are approved in writing by the City.
4. Contractor agrees that it is subject to audit and review on request by the City. If contractor has a financial audit prepared, that report shall be furnished to the City's Convention and Visitors Bureau.
5. Contractor agrees that all funds received from the City will be expended as approved by City Council and none of the funds shall be diverted to any other use or purpose, except as recommended by the Convention & Visitors Bureau's Advisory Board and as approved by the City Council. Full records of all expenditures and disbursements and any income from the provision of the program described in Contractor's proposal shall be kept and open to City inspection during regular business hours.
6. Contractor agrees to provide the Convention and Visitors Bureau with copies of all financial documentation no later than 90 days following the last day of the funded event, as outlined in the Post-Event Documentation Procedures. Documentation must include copies of checks issued for payment of services or items, copies of corresponding invoices and copies of any required contracts. If Contractor does not provide financial documentation, they may not be eligible for future funding.
7. Contractor agrees that the Convention and Visitors Bureau and the City will be recognized as outlined in the Contractor's proposal.

RE: Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute an Agreement with the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association for Sports Development Funds.

SUMMARY: In March 2006, the City Council approved guidelines for a new Tourism Development Program: the Sports Development Fund (SDF), which provides funding for new sports events and significant expansions of existing sports events. This is the third program under the umbrella of the Tourism Development Program. The other two are the Festivals and Events Fund and the Attraction Development Fund.

The Missouri Basketball Coaches Association (MBCA) has applied for \$10,000 for a coaches' clinic to be held October 18-19, 2007 on the campus of Columbia College and University of Missouri.

DISCUSSION: This is the second year for this event. In 2006, almost 800 coaches attended and this year the clinic is expanding to over 1,000 coaches. MBCA is also partnering with Special Olympics Missouri to help promote their program locally, statewide and regionally and there will be top-notch coaching talent for the clinics, which will include Coach Roy Williams of North Carolina. We expect the event to generate nearly 1,000 room nights.

The Convention and Visitors Bureau Advisory board met on August 27, 2007 to review the application and voted to approve funding the clinic at \$10,000.
