**AN ORDINANCE**

authorizing an agreement with the Columbia School District to provide crosswalk guards at Benton, Derby Ridge, Field, Paxton Keeley, Mill Creek, Shepard Boulevard, West Boulevard and Grant Elementary Schools for the 2008 summer school session; appropriating funds; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Columbia School District to provide crosswalk guards at Benton, Derby Ridge, Field, Paxton Keeley, Mill Creek, Shepard Boulevard, West Boulevard and Grant Elementary Schools for the 2008 summer school session. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as fully as if set forth herein verbatim.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$325.00 is hereby appropriated from the Miscellaneous Income Account No. 110-2121-480.10-00 to the Temporary Positions Account No. 110-2121-511.01-05.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

**AGREEMENT**

This agreement is entered into on this \_\_\_\_ day of July, 2008 between the Columbia School District ("District") and the City of Columbia, Missouri ("City").

The parties agree as follows:

1. City will hire and assign full-time crosswalk guards at seven Columbia Public Schools – Benton, Derby Ridge, Field, Paxton Keeley, Mill Creek, Shepard Boulevard and West Boulevard Elementary Schools. A full-time crosswalk guard shall be assigned to Grant Elementary School for three weeks.
2. The crosswalk guards will be employed for the 2008 summer school session.
3. District will pay City \$3,325.00 for the services provided by the crosswalk guards during the above service period.

**Summary:**

The attached Council Bill appropriates funds and authorizes the Columbia Police Department to enter into a crosswalk guard agreement with the Columbia Public Schools. Columbia Public Schools agree to reimburse the City of Columbia one hundred percent (100%) of the salary cost of a full-time crosswalk guard at seven Columbia Public Schools - Benton, Derby Ridge, Field, Paxton Keeley, Millcreek, Shepard and West Boulevard , and three weeks at Grant Elementary school.

These crosswalk guards will be employed for the 2008 summer school. Columbia Public Schools will pay the City of Columbia \$3,325.00.
