BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Columbia School District to provide a crosswalk guard at Grant Elementary School. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as fully as if set forth herein verbatim.

AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into on this _____ day of July, 2008 between the Columbia School District ("District") and the City of Columbia, Missouri ("City").

The parties agree as follows:

1. City will hire and assign a crosswalk guard at Grant Elementary School, 10 E. Broadway, Columbia, MO 65203.
2. The crosswalk guard will be employed for the 2008 – 2009 school year.
2. District will pay City \$3,500.00 for the services provided by the crosswalk guard during the above service period.
