AN ORDINANCE

accepting and appropriating donated funds for Stephens Lake Park development projects; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City accepts donations made by the Cosmopolitan Luncheon Club (\$12,500.00) for the Reichmann Pavilion, Ed Petersheim (\$10,000.00) for construction of a second waterfall at Stephens Lake Park and a \$1,000.00 donation for Memorial/Heritage trees at Stephens Lake Park.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$23,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Stephens Lake Park Donations Account No. 753-8500-480.53-25, D74025 to the Stephens Lake Park Development Account No. 440-8800-548.49-90, C00095.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



RE: Donation Appropriation - Stephens Lake Park

Summary: The Department of Parks and Recreation is requesting Council action to appropriate \$23,500 in donated funds for Stephens Lake Park. The funds have been received over the past several months and are being appropriated at this time so that development of the project can continue as planned.

Discussion:

Donations include \$12,500 from the Cosmopolitan Luncheon Club for the Riechmann Pavilion (\$50,000 total donation paid in four annual installments), \$10,000 from Ed Petersheim for the second waterfall, and \$1,000 for Memorial/Heritage trees at Stephens Lake Park.

The second waterfall is identified in the final master plan for Stephens Lake Park and was unfunded until now. Ed Petersheim has donated \$10,000 to construct the second waterfall. The first waterfall was funded by a \$50,000 donation from the Nall family, which also included the pump and pump housing. The second waterfall can be built for a substantially less price, as it will be much smaller in scope and will use the same pump installed for the first waterfall. This donation enables staff to have both waterfalls constructed at the same time.

An appropriation of donated funds is requested at this time so that development of the project can continue as planned.

Suggested Council Action: Approve the ordinance appropriating the funds.
