AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to prohibit parking on a portion of the south side of Lansing Avenue; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-324. Parking prohibited.

When signs are placed, erected or installed in each block, giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or places hereinafter set forth:

...

Lansing Avenue, both sides, from Keene Street to Portland Street.

Lansing Avenue, south side, from Portland Street to Dene Drive.

LaSalle Place, west side, from Allen Street to Worley.

...

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

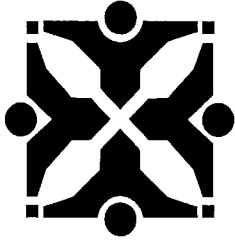

Re: Prohibit Parking on a Portion of Lansing Avenue (CM 3853)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for council consideration an ordinance amending Section 14-324 of the Code of Ordinances to prohibit parking on the south side of Lansing Avenue from Portland Street to Dene Drive.

DISCUSSION:

At the July 1, 2013 Council meeting, staff prepared a report recommending a parking prohibition on a portion of Lansing Avenue, from Portland Street to Dene Drive, to allow better traffic flow in the area (see attached diagram). Council directed staff to prepare an ordinance amending Section 14-324 to reflect the recommendation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$300 from the Street Maintenance budget for materials, equipment, and labor.

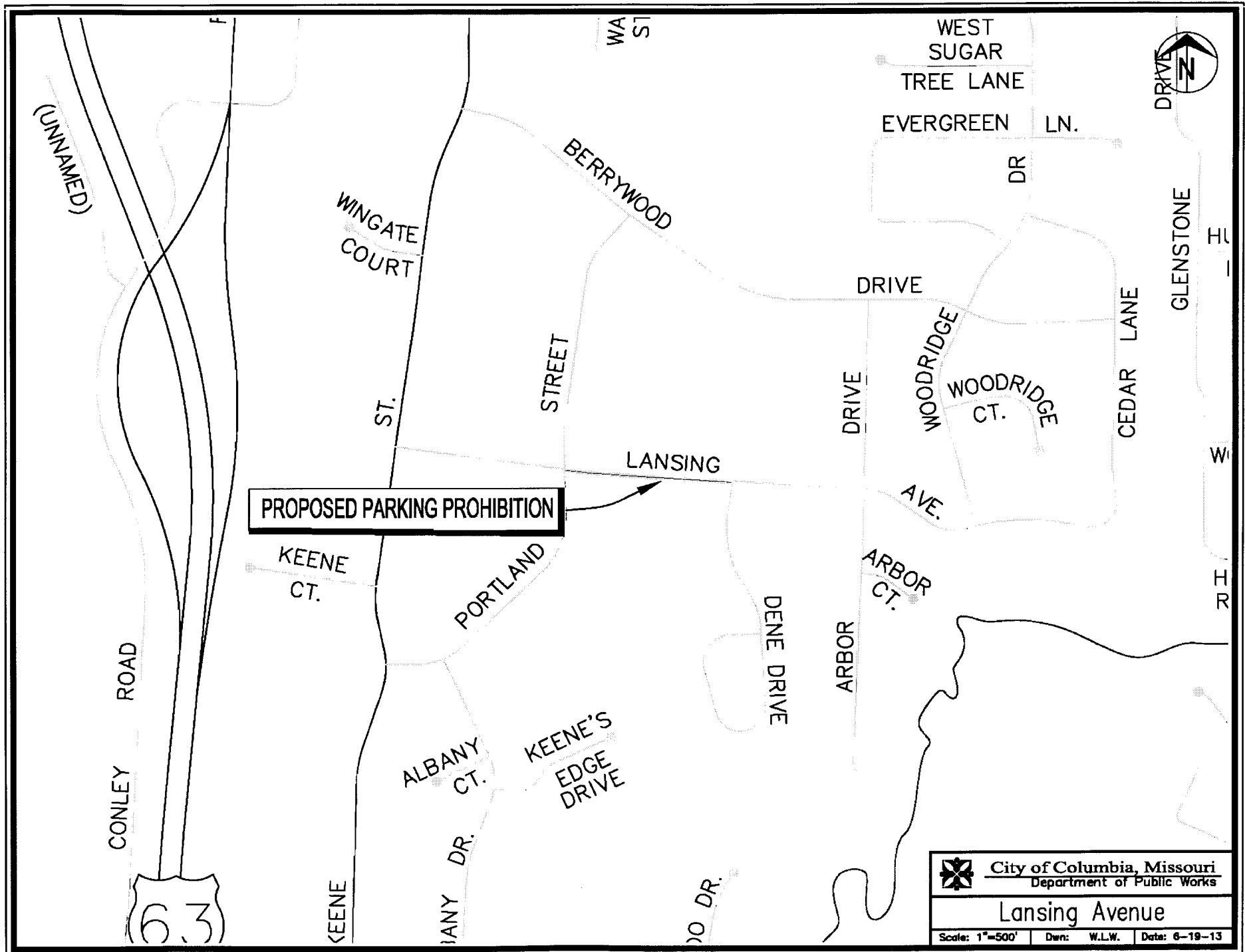
