AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to prohibit parking on a portion of Madison Street; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-324. Parking prohibited.

When signs are placed, erected or installed in each block, giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or places hereinafter set forth:

...

Lowry Street, both sides, from Ninth Street to Hitt Street.

Madison Street, east side, from Business Loop 70 south 250 feet.

Maguire Boulevard, beginning at the northeast corner of the south intersection with LeMone Industrial Boulevard, thence east and north two thousand three hundred twenty-five (2,325) feet.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



Re: Parking Prohibition on a Portion of Madison Street

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing an amendment to Section 14-324 of the City Code to prohibit parking along a portion of the east side of Madison Street, approximately 250 feet south of Business Loop 70.

DISCUSSION:

At the August 16, 2013 Council meeting, staff was directed to bring forward an ordinance to prohibit parking along a portion of Madison Street. Staff believes that removing parking on one side could help to enhance traffic flow. In addition, a GetAbout project planned along Madison Street to enhance bicycle connectivity, could benefit from the parking prohibition by reducing the possibility of vehicle/bicycle conflicts.

Since there could be a shift in parking demand to other locations with this parking prohibition, staff will mark the curb yellow 40' south of Business Loop 70 on the west side, and at some driveway locations. These restrictions will help to better define areas where vehicles should not park.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Materials estimated to cost \$350, and will be paid from Street Operations.
