AN ORDINANCE

accepting a donation from the Downtown Community Improvement District for the purchase of a John Deere Gator™ 825i to be used by the Police Department for patrolling the downtown area; appropriating funds; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City accepts a donation in the amount of \$13,375.89 from the Downtown Community Improvement District for the purchase of a John Deere Gator™ 825i to be used by the Police Department for patrolling the downtown area.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$13,375.89 is hereby appropriated from the Police Donations Account No. 753-8500-480.53-21 to the following accounts:


