Re: Supplemental Information for Public Hearing - Ashland Road Sidewalk and Intersection project

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a supplemental report concerning the public hearing for the Ashland Road Sidewalk and Intersection project. Attached to this report is the contact log for council review.

DISCUSSION:

Council passed Resolution 221-13 on November 4, 2013, which set a public hearing for December 2, 2013. Staff has attempted to contact adjacent property owners prior to the scheduled public hearing for the Ashland Road Sidewalk and Intersection project. The contact log is attached for Council review.

MoDOT has indicated that crosswalks on all legs of intersection on their facilities may need to be upgraded as improvements are planned and constructed. They are currently evaluating the existing conditions at the project site and the proposed improvements to determine if further upgrades are necessary. If applicable, additional improvements will be incorporated into the design of this project.

Re: Public Hearing - Ashland Road Sidewalk and Intersection

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration legislation setting a public hearing for December 2, 2013, for the construction of sidewalk improvements on the east side of Ashland Road from Stadium Boulevard to East Campus Loop Drive as shown on the attached location map. An interested parties (IP) meeting was held September 9, 2013.

DISCUSSION:

The Ashland Road Sidewalk and Intersection project, from Stadium Boulevard to East Campus Loop Drive is part of the Non-Motorized Transportation (GetAbout) program. Preliminary design of this project was completed under original GetAbout Round I funding. The project includes replacing the existing bike lane on the east side of Ashland Road with a raised 6-ft wide sidewalk beginning on the south side of Stadium Boulevard and continuing north, tying into the existing sidewalk at East Campus Loop Drive. The bike lane will be re-striped within the remaining northbound lane, and the bike lane along the southbound lane will remain. The concept includes approximately 990 linear feet of sidewalk with a curbed island and pedestrian signals at the Ashland/Stadium intersection. One concrete driveway will need to be reconstructed to comply with ADA requirements. Staff anticipates one tree (8" cedar) will be removed to construct this project. Current preliminary typical section and plan view diagrams are attached. Staff anticipates construction to be completed by the end of 2014.

An IP meeting was held for this project on September 9, 2013. The meeting was lightly attended with just two (2) people signing in. Both attendees were supportive of the project, and no official comments were received.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The current project cost estimate is \$256,000, and will be paid from the GetAbout grant. To date, \$51,200 has been appropriated to the project.






Following Council discussion and public input, Council should make motion directing staff to proceed with plans and specifications for this project.

A RESOLUTION

declaring the necessity for construction of a sidewalk on the east side of Ashland Road, between Stadium Boulevard and East Campus Loop Drive, and a raised island and signals at the intersection of Ashland Road and Stadium Boulevard; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the improvement; providing for payment for the improvement; providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law; and setting a public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council deems the construction of a six-foot wide sidewalk on the east side of Ashland Road between Stadium Boulevard and East Campus Loop Drive, a raised island and signals at the intersection of Ashland Road and Stadium Boulevard, reconstruction of a driveway to meet ADA requirements, and other miscellaneous work, all in accordance with City of Columbia Street and Storm Sewer Specifications and Standards, in the City of Columbia, Missouri, more specifically described as the Ashland Road Sidewalk and Intersection Project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 2. The nature and scope of the improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$256,000.00.

SECTION 4. Payment for this improvement shall be made from Non-Motorized Transportation Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. Any work done in connection with the construction of the improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri. The City shall also cause to be inserted into the contract a stipulation that all laborers and mechanics employed by the contractor or subcontractors in the performance of work under the contract shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on similar construction in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act.

SECTION 6. A public hearing in respect to this improvement will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on December 2, 2013. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.
