A RESOLUTION

authorizing the periodic closure of Discovery Ridge, and the temporary closure of sidewalks along both sides of Discovery Ridge, between Ponderosa Street and East Gans Road, to facilitate a mass grading project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Trittenbach Development to periodically close Discovery Ridge, and temporarily close the sidewalks along both sides of Discovery Ridge, located between Ponderosa Street and East Gans Road, as shown on "Exhibit A," from December 5, 2013 to June 1, 2014 to facilitate a mass grading project.

SECTION 2. Trittenbach Development shall close the street and sidewalks only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying Trittenbach Development, in writing, of such requirements. Trittenbach Development shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the street and sidewalks due to any damage caused by the construction activity. Trittenbach Development shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. Trittenbach Development shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary street and sidewalk closures without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the street and sidewalk closure permit by the City Council.



Re: Allowing Trittenbach Development to Intermittently Close a Portion of Discovery Parkway and Temporary Closure of Sidewalks along Discovery Parkway

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration legislation authorizing Trittenbach Development to intermittently close a portion of Discovery Parkway to allow earth-moving equipment to cross the street, and authorizing the closure of the sidewalks along Discovery Parkway at the same location.

DISCUSSION:

Trittenbach Development is seeking permission to intermittently close 45 linear feet of street pavement on Discovery Parkway, between Ponderosa Street and E. Gans Road, to allow for earth-moving equipment to facilitate a mass grading project (see attached location diagram). The road will be closed only while earth-hauling equipment (agricultural tractors pulling double-pan scrapers) cross Discovery Parkway. No hard-tire or Euclid trucks are allowable. Additionally, Trittenbach Development has requested the closure of 45 linear feet of sidewalk on both sides of Discovery Parkway at the same location.

The work will begin December 5, 2013 and shall be completed by June 1, 2014. Upon completion of the work, Trittenbach Development will remove and replace the street pavement and sidewalk located within the crossing. Trittenbach Development will also be responsible to remove and replace any other infrastructure which may be damaged by the work. Staff has reviewed the traffic control plan (attached) and has no issues with their request.

Trittenbach Development shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public, and shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.
