Re: Traffic Calming Modifications along Elleta Boulevard

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration legislation authoring an agreement with the Columbia Housing Authority (CHA) for traffic calming modifications along Elleta Boulevard. CHA has requested that consideration be given to adding speed humps and Kid Friendly speed limit signs along Elleta, and Public Works staff agrees that the requested traffic calming would be beneficial for this area.

DISCUSSION:

CHA is pursuing two traffic calming speed humps along Elleta Boulevard to encourage lower speeds and increase overall pedestrian safety in the area. The speed humps will be located on the east and west sides of the Elleta Boulevard high point, spaced at approximately 500 feet (see attached diagrams). The eastern speed hump is located near the entrance to the CHA playground, to slow drivers in this area.

An Interested Parties meeting was not held for this project, as Elleta Boulevard is a terminal street and CHA owns the property on both sides of the area of interest, to the east end of Elleta Boulevard. The two western most properties on Elleta Boulevard are not owned by CHA, but are not likely to travel east on Elleta Boulevard, and there is no future plan to extend this street.

The estimated cost of this project is \$10,000, and per the agreement, CHA will compensate the City this amount. Street Operations personnel will install the devices and signs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total cost is estimated at \$10,000, with CHA paying up to \$10,000 for this traffic calming project. Maintenance of the signs is estimated at \$117 per year, and will be funded as part of normal annual street maintenance.
