Adopt-A-Spot Beautification Agreements

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Volunteer Programs is submitting for approval three Adopt-A-Spot Beautification agreements to allow volunteers to care for landscaping in street right of way.

DISCUSSION:

Volunteers maintain more than 90 landscaped beds in city or state right of way in the City of Columbia. Adopters are responsible for weeding, watering, and mulching the beds and planting annual flowers and bulbs. Agreements are written for a four-year commitment and each bed has a sign to acknowledge the efforts of the adopter.

Staff is submitting three agreements for approval. Two of the three are new beds to the program while the third is an existing bed that needs a new adopter.

- Debbie Danner has agreed to adopt the bed located in the median of Stadium Boulevard just east of US 63. This bed was constructed as part of the development project, however the developer will not be continuing maintenance due to the lack of water installed to this bed. Ms. Danner will be caring for this bed without water and City staff will work with her on a planting and maintenance plan that can function without irrigation. Staff have investigated having a water meter installed to serve this bed and believe it to be cost prohibitive.
- The Battle High School Athletic Department will be adopting a roundabout located at Clark Lane and St. Charles Road in east Columbia. This bed will need to be planted in the spring. City staff will work with students and teachers to develop a planting plan and schedule a work day for installation.
- The Boyer Family has agreed to adopt the roundabout located at the intersection of Bull Run and Port Way near the Lake of the Woods exit of I-70 on the east side of Columbia. While this bed had a previous adopter, the planting will essentially begin from scratch this spring.

City staff will work with these volunteers to provide mulch, annual flowers, bulbs and replacement plants as needed to help them be successful. The City's Volunteer Programs staff appreciates the investment that volunteers put into Adopt-A-Spot beds to be enjoyed by hundreds of residents and visitors each day.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will assist with ongoing support by providing mulch, bulbs, annual flowers, and replacement plants as needed. The City will pay for a sign to acknowledge the work of each adopter at a cost of \$130 per sign. Labor, which is the largest expense in maintaining the beds, will be provided by adopter.
