Executive Summary

The purpose of this ordinance is to offer the memorandum of agreement between the County of Boone, Missouri and City of Columbia, Missouri for a 40-60% split of available funds on the established disparity formula. This will result in the city's share of the funds being \$27,741.60 to purchase equipment.

Discussion

Through a written signed agreement between the City of Columbia, Missouri and County of Boone, Missouri, an award in the form of a grant for law enforcement equipment could be obtained. This action is not acceptance of the funding. This is one of the necessary steps to comply with the application conditions.

This grant will be used to purchase nine (9) Motorola XTS 2500 Portable Radios (depending on cost estimates) for the police department.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$27,741.60 will be the Columbia Police Department's share of this grant's funding and will be used to replace existing radio's that are beyond their estimated life and in need of replacement. The radio's cost approximately \$3,390 each (based on a recent estimate). There will be no additional cost to the city for the next two years.

Long-Term Impact: This grant will be used to replace existing radio's, there will be no additional costs to the city for years beyond two.

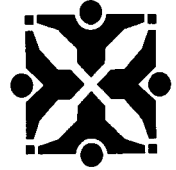

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the County of Boone relating to the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program and the allocation of FY 2014 funding. **INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
 THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI AND COUNTY
 OF BOONE, MISSOURI**

**EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM
 FY 2014 LOCAL SOLICITATION**

This Agreement is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2014, by and between The **COUNTY of BOONE**, acting by and through its governing body, the County Commission, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the **CITY of COLUMBIA**, acting by and through its City Manager, hereinafter referred to as CITY, both of Boone County, State of Missouri.

WHEREAS, both parties are empowered to enter into cooperative agreements for the purposes herein stated pursuant to Section 70.220 RSMo; and

WHEREAS, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party; and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties anticipate a total allocation under this grant in the amount of \$46,236.00 hereinafter referred to as JAG funds, to COUNTY; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CITY believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

Section 1.

COUNTY agrees to pay CITY a total of Sixty Percent (60%) of JAG funds received herein, or an anticipated \$27,741.60 of JAG funds. COUNTY is the Applicant / Fiscal Agent for the joint funds.

Section 2.

COUNTY agrees to use a total of Forty Percent (40%) of JAG funds received herein for approved program(s), or an anticipated \$18,494.40 of JAG funds.

Section 3.

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

Section 4.

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

Section 5.

By entering into this Agreement, the parties do not intend to create any obligations express or implied other than those set out herein; further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.
