Executive Summary

Resolution setting a public hearing for September 2, 2014 to consider proposed amendments to Chapters 13, 22 and 27 of the City Code of Ordinances relating to structure changes to the sanitary sewer utility rates, sewer utility connection fees, and increase of the waste hauler disposal service fees.

Discussion

In order to provide adequate funding to meet current bond obligations, and to operate and maintain the sewer utility, staff is recommending that Chapters 13, 22 and 27 of the City Code be amended to implement structural rate changes in connection with the November 2013 revenue bond package presented to the voters for sanitary sewer utility capital improvements.

The November 2013 ballot issue projected that revenue increases of 6% in FY2015, 5% in FY2017 and 2% in FY2019, were necessary in order to pay the revenue bonds issued to construct \$32,340,000 of sanitary sewer improvements promised to the voters. This is the first of three anticipated changes as recommended by our consultant, Burton & Associates.

Following is a list of the recommended rate structure changes, and increase of the waste hauler disposal service fees effective October 1, 2014.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: Anticipated revenue increases for FY15 include: sanitary sewer utility rates of \$1,103,366; sewer connection fees of \$387,500; and anticipated waste hauler fee increase of \$2,040. Long-Term Impact: A 5% increase is anticipated for FY17 and a 2% increase for FY19.
