Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to the professional engineering services agreement with Engineering Surveys and Services, LLC for design of the College Avenue Safety Enhancements (CASE) project. The amendment is necessary in order to extend the date that the design project will be approved by MoDOT for construction bidding.

Discussion

On August 19, 2013, Council adopted Resolution 159-13 authorizing a professional engineering services agreement with Engineering Surveys and Services, LLC for the design of the College Avenue Safety Enhancements (CASE) project. The consultant's scope of services for this project included surveying, engineering design and final construction documents necessary to construct the project.

The agreement specifies that the Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) approval by MoDOT shall be completed on August 15, 2014. This amendment extends that date to December 15, 2014. An ordinance authorizing a bid call through the Purchasing division for the construction of this project, is included on the September 2nd council agenda with second reading and approval by Council on September 15, 2014.
