Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Manager to execute a Road Maintenance Cooperative Agreement with Boone County, Missouri for 2015. The cooperative agreement establishes the responsibilities of the City and County concerning maintenance of certain sections of roads.

Discussion

Each year, the City and County evaluate roadways that are partially located within Columbia's city limits to determine appropriate maintenance treatments. Page 2 of the cooperative agreement with Boone County identifies the roads that will be chip and fog sealed by the County, and the roads scheduled for mill and overlay, and chip seal, by the City. Maintenance costs are included in Street Division's annual operating budget.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact:. The estimated cost of maintenance to be performed by the County is \$22,788.05. The estimated cost of maintenance to be performed by the City is \$27,288.14, a difference of \$4,500.09. If the actual cost of the work performed is as estimated, the County will pay the City the difference. Maintenance costs are included in Street Division's annual operating budget. BOONE COUNTY AND CITY OF COLUMBIA ROAD MAINTENANCE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

2015 Pavement Preservation Projects

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between Boone County, Missouri, through its County Commission, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri (hereinafter "Boone County"), and the City of Columbia, Missouri, a political subdivision of the State of Missouri (hereinafter "City").

WHEREAS, County and City desire to cooperate with each other on the maintenance of certain roadways in which both County and City have certain maintenance obligations; and

WHEREAS, the parties are authorized pursuant to the provisions of RSMo §70.220 to enter into this cooperative agreement; and

WHEREAS, cooperation between the parties for the purposes herein stated is intended to benefit each through the containment and reduction of associated costs as well as provide for the preservation and maintenance of the impacted roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representations in this agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this agreement is to formalize the understanding between the parties regarding the sharing of costs associated with pavement preservation work to be done as part of the 2015 construction season.
- 2. <u>SHARED MAINTENANCE OBLIGATIONS</u>: Currently the County and the City have shared maintenance obligations for the roads referenced in the attached maps and herein. The purpose of this document is to formalize an agreement for the preventative maintenance of these roads in the 2015 construction season.

3. LOCATION:

The locations of the shared cost projects can be found on the attached maps, which are incorporated herein by reference.

4. WORK CONTEMPLATED: County and City will perform, with its own forces or through a contractor, application of road oil, application of Osage River rock, Iron Mountain Trap Rock, or like aggregate, sweeping, and other associated preparatory work to complete the 2015 Preservation Chip Seal projects. County will, through a contractor, perform Fog Seal treatments using GSB-88 or other sealant. Some roads, as shown in the below tables, will receive both a Preservation Chip Seal and a Fog Seal. The City will perform with its own forces or through a contractor a 1.5" mill (concrete) and asphalt overlay. If paint striping is needed on a road, it will be the responsibility of the party that performed the projects as shown in this document.

5. <u>COST</u>: The costs for the Preservation Chip Seal projects, the Fog Seal projects, and the mill and asphalt overlay project were calculated based on the surface area of pavement to be treated in areas of responsibility for each party and are summarized below.

- (a) If the amount of work performed is of the same scope as what was estimated, the estimated quantity will be used for billing. If the scope of work is directed to be changed, the actual quantity of work performed will be used for billing.
- (b) The actual unit cost will be used for billing. The City will submit to the County actual costs for work performed by City or its contractor within 60 days of completion of the work or prior to December 1st, whichever comes first.
- (c) Upon the completion of all work, if the balance of the project totals is such that the County owes the City, the County will pay the City for the balance owed. If the City owes the County, the County will submit a bill to the City for the balance owed.
- 7. <u>AUTHORITY</u>: The individuals signing this agreement below certify that they have obtained the appropriate authority to execute this agreement on behalf of the respective parties.










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2015 Pavement Preservation Shared Cost Projects Prairie/Prairieview - Mill & Overlay
