Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution setting a public hearing for March 16, 2015 concerning the replacement of aging water distribution infrastructure along Texas Avenue from Garth Avenue to Creasy Springs Road. The estimated cost for this improvement is \$950,000 and funding has been appropriated under project WT0245 of the Capital Improvement Program. Staff conducted an interested parties meeting for this project on January 27, 2015.

Discussion

The Columbia Water and Light Department has identified the need to replace aging water distribution infrastructure on Texas Avenue from Garth Avenue to Creasy Springs Road in conjunction with the Public Works Department's 2015 street mill and overlay program. This project will replace an existing 6" cast iron main on Texas Avenue from Creasy springs Road to Garth Avenue. This water main is approaching the end of its useful life and the high frequency of leaks and water main breaks necessitate replacement of the main. The existing 6" cast iron main will be replaced with new 8" and 12" PVC pipe. The upgraded main will increase water flows to the area for consumer and fire protection needs as well as increase the maintainability and dependability of the area's water distribution infrastructure. This project, in conjunction with the proposed 16" water main crossing of Interstate 70 at Parkade Boulevard, will increase water distribution reliability.

The current design for this project will utilize existing street right of way for replacement of the water main within the street pavement along the south edge of Texas Avenue. Connections with existing water mains will be extended outward with new materials in order to minimize future work required within Texas Avenue right of way. All customer service lines will be transferred to the new main to allow for the abandonment of the older mains and decrease the amount of maintenance needed in the area. This improvement is intended to precede plans by the Public Works Department to overlay Texas Avenue as part of their 2015 street mill and overlay program. Because the new main will be constructed within existing street right of way, no additional easements will be necessary for the completion of this project.

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Upon City Council approval for this water main replacement project, final plans and specifications will be prepared and issued to city forces for construction.
