Executive Summary

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Citizen Participation rules require jurisdictions to consider any comments or views of citizens at a public hearing prior to submitting an amendment to the the Consolidated Plan or Annual Action Plan. In order to comply with this requirement, staff has prepared a resolution setting a public hearing on the CDBG and HOME 2015 Annual Action Plan for May 18, 2015. The full report will be provided to the Council prior to the public hearing.

Discussion

The Council approved a draft version of the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan and 2015 Annual Action Plan on October 16, 2014 and adopted an amendment to the FY 2015 Annual Action Plan on March 16, 2015. This amendment includes a reallocation of HOME funds from 208 Ridgeway to 802 Hirth and 110 Lynn. Funding reallocation is being recommended due to the City selling 208 Ridgeway and redevelopment not moving forward. The City Council approved the sale of 208 Ridgeway at the April 6, 2015 Council meeting.

The Community Development Commission (CDC) recommended reallocation of \$62,500 in HOME funds for COMO CHDO (Job Point) and \$62,500 in HOME funds for Show-me Central Habitat for Humanity at the March 11th CDC meeting. The funding recommendations also include donation of 2 lots purchased with Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) funding located at 802 Hirth (to Habitat) and 110 Lynn (to COMO CHDO). Redevelopment of the lots will include 2 energy efficient affordable homes with universal design features.

Redevelopment of both lots would be anticipated to begin in July of 2015. A full report on the amendment to the 2015 Annual Action Plan will be provided to Council before the May 18, 2015 meeting.
