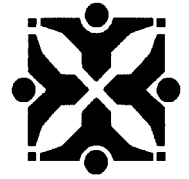

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage shall be allowed from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. for the area along a portion of Ninth Street between Walnut Street and Broadway during The Blue Note Ninth Street SummerFest concert on June 26, 2015.
