Executive Summary

Authorizing the University of Missouri Campus Facilities to close a portion of sidewalk on the west side of S. Fifth Street, between Stewart Road and Elm Street, beginning September 14, 2015 through November 20, 2015.

Discussion

The University of Missouri Campus Facilities has requested permission to close approximately 215 linear feet of sidewalk on the west side of S. Fifth Street, between Stewart Road and Elm Street, beginning Monday September 14, 2015 and ending on Friday November 20, 2015, relating to an expansion of an electrical manhole near 413 S. Fifth Street.

Staff has reviewed the attached traffic control plan and has no issues with the request. The University of Missouri Campus Facilities shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public, and shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of the sidewalk on the west side of Fifth Street between Stewart Road and Elm Street, near 413 S. Fifth Street, to facilitate the expansion of an electrical manhole.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the University of Missouri to temporarily close approximately 215 linear feet of sidewalk on the west side of Fifth Street between Stewart Road and Elm Street, near 413 S. Fifth Street, as shown on "Exhibit A," from September 14, 2015 to November 20, 2015 to allow for the expansion of an electrical manhole.

SECTION 2. The University of Missouri shall close the sidewalk only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying the University of Missouri, in writing, of such requirements. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the sidewalk due to any damage caused by the construction activity. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. The University of Missouri shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary sidewalk closure without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the sidewalk closure permit by the City Council.


