Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance appropriating 50% of the FY 2014 General Fund savings to specific projects identified by Council.

Discussion

The Council approved an Incentive Based Budgeting initiative in March, 2013 to provide an incentive for general fund departments to not spend all of their budget each year. In years when there are savings in the general fund, one half of the savings will go back to departments based on the proportion of the savings they generated. The other half of the general fund savings is allocated by the City Council. The funds are set up in project accounts which allow funds to be carried into the next year if they are not completely spent. There were general fund savings allocation in FY 2012. There were no savings to allocate in FY 2013.

The General Fund savings for FY 2014 is \$4,166,988, of which 50% of that savings, \$2,083,494 goes to Council for various projects. This ordinance only appropriates \$2,065,000. The remaining balance of \$18,494 will stay in the General Fund balance.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The General Fund reserve will be reduced for FY 2015, but will still be significantly above the 20% policy.

Long-Term Impact: None.

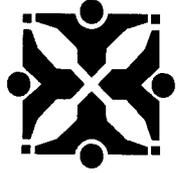

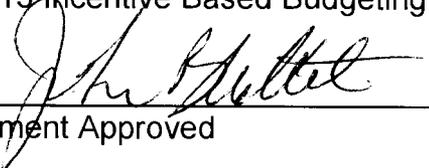

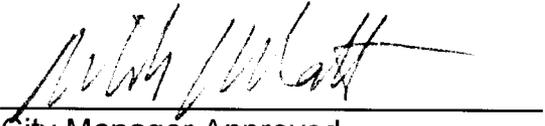

AN ORDINANCE

appropriating FY 2014 General Fund savings for projects identified by the City Council as part of the Incentive Based Budgeting Initiative; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:
