Executive Summary

Public hearing for the construction of bus shelters at various locations throughout the city, as shown on the attached location map. An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held August 13, 2015.

Discussion

The Bus Shelters project includes purchasing and installing 18 bus shelters at 14 locations throughout the city as follows:

- 1.) One (1) shelter on the north side of Broadway, approximately 600 feet west of Stadium Boulevard.
- 2.) One (1) shelter on the north side of Bernadette Drive, approximately 525 feet west of Stadium Boulevard.
- 3.) One (1) shelter on the east side of Forum Boulevard, approximately 125 feet north of Nifong Boulevard.
- 4.) One (1) shelter on the south side of Worley Street, just west of West Boulevard.
- 5.) One (1) shelter on the north side of Worley Street, just west of Oak Street.
- 6.) One (1) shelter on the north side of Worley Street, just west of Woodlawn Avenue.
- 7.) Two (2) shelters on Conley Road (east and west side), just south of the recently installed traffic signal at the Shoppes at Broadway entrance.
- 8.) One (1) shelter on the south side of Rogers Street, at the intersection with Range Line Street.
- 9.) Two (2) shelters on Blue Ridge Road (north and south side), just east of the Providence Road.
- 10.) Two (2) shelters on White Gate Drive (north and south side), just west of Sylvan Lane.

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- 11.) One (1) shelter on Southampton Drive, approximately 350 feet west of State Farm Parkway.
- 12.) One (1) shelter on the north side of Worley Street, just east of Garth Avenue.
- 13.) Two (2) shelters on Broadway (north and south side), just west of Garth Avenue.
- 14.) One (1) shelter on the south side of Vandiver Drive, approximately 825 feet west of Parker Street.

Bus shelter locations were chosen based upon riders, Doublemap system report which identifies the most popular and used bus stop locations, a public input meeting, and a community-wide vote in February and March of 2015.

City staff worked the University of Missouri Architectural Studies program to select the shelter design from the winner of a student design competition. Design oversight was provided by COMO Connect staff, bus riders, the City's Transportation Advisory Commission, and professional architect and MU professor Michael Goldschmidt. The new shelters will be ADA compliant and incorporate user features such as LED lighting.

The estimated cost of each shelter is approximately \$11,000. The cost of installation at each location will vary based on site conditions, easement acquisition, sidewalk installation/replacement, etc. It is expected that ten (10) permanent easements will be needed from ten (10) separate property owners.

The budget for this project is \$569,705. Funding sources include \$100,000 from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), \$375,764 from a Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant, and a \$93,941 match from the local Transportation Sales Tax.

An IP meeting was held on August 13, 2015; two (2) people signed in and two (2) comments were received.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The budget for this project is \$569,705. Funding sources include \$100,000 from CDBG funds, \$375,764 from an FTA grant, and a \$93,941 match from the local Transportation Sales Tax.

Long-Term Impact: Staff anticipates maintenance costs of bus shelters will not significantly impact the current operational budget. Current shelters require infrequent repairs and have a projected useful life of 20 years. Adding new shelters to the cleaning and maintenance schedule will impact the budget for no more than\$100 per shelter annually.




