### **Executive Summary**

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance appropriating \$67,504.

#### Discussion

During the FY 2015 budgeting process, the budget for the Sewer Utility included a supplemental item to convert a fuel oil boiler to a natural gas boiler. This conversion was not completed during fiscal year 15 and the \$67,504 needed to complete the conversion needs to be appropriated for use during the 2016 fiscal year.
