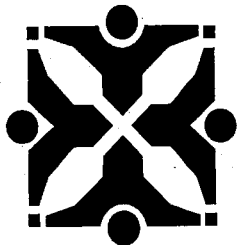

Re: Resolution to set a public hearing on adoption of Columbia Imagined (**Case # 13-82**)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A request by the City of Columbia to adopt a new comprehensive plan entitled "Columbia Imagined - The Plan for How We Live & Grow". This plan will replace Metro 2020, adopted in February 2001, and will provide land use and policy guidance for residents, professional staff, and appointed and elected officials. The plan period extends through the year 2030. The document may be amended from time to time in response to changing conditions. (Case #13-82).

DISCUSSION:

On June 6, 2013, the Planning and Zoning Commission held its public hearing on the adoption of the City's new comprehensive plan entitled "Columbia Imagined - The Plan for How We Live & Grow". Throughout the planning process 26 public engagement meetings were held, 700 public input surveys collected, and over 80,000 citizens were directly asked to participate in the planning process.

As the City concludes its work on the new plan it is believed one final public hearing before the City Council should be held. This hearing will ensure that the most inclusive public engagement process is made available. Such hearing would allow residents or interested parties to address concerns or issues with the plan to the elected officials prior to second reading and final adoption.

If Council agrees that one additional public hearing is appropriate, it is recommended that a public hearing be scheduled for July 1, 2013.
