SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a sidewalk renovation agreement with the Bette H. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as fully as if set forth herein verbatim.

SECTION 2. At the request of the City Manager, the City Council hereby transfers \$19,920.00 from the Downtown Sidewalk Improvement Project Account No. 440-8800-528.49-90, C00171 to Trops Sidewalk Project Account No. 440-8800-528.49-90, C00547.

SIDEWALK RENOVATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into on this _____ day of _____, 2013 by and between the City of Columbia, Missouri, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and the Bette H. Douglass Trust.

WHEREAS, the Bette H. Douglass Trust owns or operates commercial properties located at 515 E. Broadway; and

WHEREAS, the Bette H. Douglass Trust is currently in the process of extensive renovation and restoration, and removal and replacement of adjacent sidewalks, curbs and accessories; and

WHEREAS, such removal of the old sidewalks and their replacement and rebuilding to current City codes will be a benefit to City and all who will use such sidewalks, curbs and accessories.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set out herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Bette H. Douglass Trust, through its contractor, shall remove the sidewalks, curbs, parking meters, trash cans, tree grates and any other accessories, per City codes and follow the specific directions of the City Public Works Department, along East Broadway as such are adjacent to the Bette H. Douglass Trust properties.
- 2. The Bette H. Douglass Trust, through its contractor, shall replace all sidewalks, curbs, tree grates and accessories removed above as instructed by City and in accordance with City standards and codes currently in effect.
- City will reimburse the Bette H. Douglass Trust for one-half the cost of the replacement of sidewalks, curbs, etc., set out above, provided that City's contribution to such costs shall not exceed \$ 19,920.00.
- 4. City will pay the Bette H. Douglass Trust up to ninety-five percent (95%) of the amount promised as City's reimbursement within thirty (30) days of receipt of a written statement of construction cost to replace the curbs, sidewalks, etc., set out herein. City will pay the Bette H. Douglass Trust the remaining five percent (5%) of the amount promised upon City's acceptance of the work.
- 5. The Bette H. Douglass Trust agrees to comply with the provisions of the Missouri Prevailing Wage Act (Sections 290.210 through 290.340 RSMo.) and shall provide in the contract with its contractor that not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages shall be paid to all workers performing work under the contract that is required under this sidewalk renovation agreement.

6. This agreement is made solely for the benefit of the party's hereto and not for the benefit of any third party.

Re: Sidewalk Cost Share Agreement for Tropical Liqueurs

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Sidewalk Renovation agreement with Bette H. Douglass Trust for Tropical Liqueurs located at 515 E Broadway, and transferring funds from the Downtown Sidewalks Improvement project. This request falls under the Sidewalk Maintenance and Construction policy approved by Council on December 3, 2007, per ordinance 19747.

DISCUSSION:

The tenant of Tropical Liqueurs has requested assistance from the City to share the cost of replacing the sidewalks along their south property line adjacent to Broadway. Their facility and site is undergoing reconstruction and the General Contractor, Design Built, Inc., has submitted three quotes for the sidewalk construction. The low bid is from Northface Concrete Construction for \$39,840.00. Per the Sidewalk Renovation agreement, once the work is complete, the City will reimburse 50% of the cost associated with the replacement of the sidewalk, for a not to exceed amount of \$19,920.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City's share of the sidewalk replacement project is \$19,920, and will be paid from the Downtown Sidewalk Improvement project.

TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN




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
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
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






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
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
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
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


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
