Plan for subcommittees

- hold a meeting in the next month
- pick a lead person to keep subcommittee work on track, and a lead person for each topic group
- identify stakeholders (individuals, commissions, boards, organizations, businesses - can use the vision report) for each topic group - **KEEP UNDERREPRESENTED GROUPS IN MIND!**
- set up a public meeting with all or as many of the stakeholders as you can for **at least two** topic groups before the September 2010 commission meeting (decide which topic groups by June meeting)
 - goal of the meeting
 - get meaningful feedback from stakeholders on the performance measures, outcome measures and progress on implementation
 - get useful suggestions for further implementation
 - set up plan for ongoing communication

- start a relationship!
- strategies to accomplish goal
 - provide the report topic section to stakeholders, ask them to bring examples of or recommendations of outcome measures to the meeting
 - have each stakeholder respond to the commission report (keep an inventory of ideas that come up that are outside the current charge of the report)
 - fill out the worksheet for our annual report based on the stakeholders' comments
- share the reports in a commission meeting July, August, or September
