June 21—Together with Drumming: Sally Burnley, a drum circle facilitator, will help provide the fun experience of creating music with African and Asian hand drums, world percussion woods, shakers and bells.

June 28—Poetry in Motion Breakdance and the Vanguard Drum and Bugle Corps: Poetry in Motion will show off their breakdancing skills from 6-7 p.m. and 7:30-8 p.m. The world-class Vanguard Drum and Bugle Corps from Santa Clara, California will perform from 7-7:30 p.m.
