The City of Columbia offers Commercial Food Waste Collections Services to local businesses and schools. **Throw** your food scraps away and help **Grow** new plants in an organic way.


Organic waste can be collected separately for composting for **less than the cost of trash disposal**. The action is the same, you simply change the container that your food scraps go into.
