



# ARE YOU A WOMAN WITHOUT ACCESS TO HEALTH INSURANCE?

## Who is eligible for the Uninsured Women's Health Services Program?

- ◆ Are between the ages of 18-55
- ◆ Have no access to employer-sponsored health insurance
- ◆ Are a Missouri resident
- ◆ Are a US citizen or eligible qualified non-citizen
- ◆ Have a social security number
- ◆ Have income less than 201% of the federal poverty level:  
\$1972/month for one person  
\$ 2669/month for two person household  
\$3366/month for three person household

## The Uninsured Women's Health Services Program includes:

- ◆ Approved methods of birth control such as IUD, drugs, and others.
- ◆ Well-woman exam, including pap smear and STD testing, once per year.
- ◆ Family planning, counseling, and education on various methods of birth control
- ◆ Drugs, supplies or devices related to the women's health services described above, when they are prescribed by a doctor or advanced practice nurse

**If you meet the criteria, you can apply** for the Uninsured Women's Health Services (UWHS) program at the Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services or the Family Support Division office. Please bring the following information when you apply:

- ◆ Photo ID
- ◆ Social security cards for all household members
- ◆ Income information for all household members (from the past 30 days)
- ◆ Birth certificate or passport (if born outside of Missouri)
