
Dear Chief Burton:

Pursuant to a request by Ms. Schrader, the Citizens Police Review Board reviewed the topic of off-duty employment of City of Columbia police officers and their ability to wear uniforms when working off-duty.

The police provided the Board with proposed Policy 1040 and Standard Operating Guideline 206.01 (effective date May 2, 2011). After review, the Board unanimously voted to endorse the ability of officers to work outside employment and to wear City of Columbia Police Department uniforms.

The Board understands that the Police Department's proposed policy manual, which includes Policy 1040, is currently under review per Sec. 19-22 of the City of Columbia Code of Ordinances. The Board would like to be informed as to the development or changes to this policy.
