APPEARED TO BE A MECHANIC AND THE OTHER WAS TRANSACTING BUSINESS WITH A CUSTOMER; THE
CUSTOMER WAS ALSO NOT WEARING A MASK. THE CUSTOMER SERVICE STAFF MEMBER HAD DARK
HAIR, MEDIUM BUILD, APPROXIMATELY 5'10" AND IN HIS 40'S. HE SPOKE TO ME AND I TOLD HIM I WAS
THERE DUE TO A MASK ORDINANCE COMPLAINT. HE SAID HE COULD NOT BE EXPECTED TO WEAR A
MASK AS HE WAS BACK AND FORTH BETWEEN THE COUNTER AND THE CAR SERVICE AREA. I SAID THAT
HE WAS CLEARLY WITHIN 6' OF HIS CUSTOMERS AND WAS EXPECTED TO WEAR A MASK AT THOSE
TIMES. HE DID NOT SEEM INTERESTED IN COOPERATION. I LEFT A COPY OF THE MASK ORDINANCE AND
THE GUIDANCE DOCUMENT FOR BUSINESSES. I SAID THIS WOULD BE FORWARDED TO THE
PROSECUTOR AND HE SHRUGGED.
