Bars were engaging in standing bar service despite the establishment not being granted a waiver for exemption per Order 2020-09. Patrons were drinking while not seated at a table/booth. _____

That these facts herein are true and constitute a violation of Section 11-98 of the Columbia Code of Ordinances for a violation of Section 1.07 of Order No. 2020-09, promulgated on August 10, 2020 by the Director of Public Health and Human Services and punishable under Section 11-81 and 1-8 of the Columbia Code of Ordinances.

Did then and there commit the following offense and the facts supporting this belief are as follows:

Based on staff estimate of total occupancy, the venue had more than the 100 person limit allowed by Order 2020-09 at the time of inspection. In order for Silverball, an entertainment venue, to operate, an operational plan must be submitted and approved. There is currently no approved, final plan on record with the Health Dept. This must be remedied before Silverball continues to operate.
