V. NEW BUSINESS (Staff reports)

A. Skov

- MoDOT is doing a Long Range Transportation plan and has provided an online survey.
- East Blvd is being connected to Conley Rd. Skov showed and described the engineering plans for the project.

B. GetAbout/Public Works - Curtis

- Discussed the pilot study that evaluated the effectiveness of bicycle detection pavement markings.
- Capital projects update:
 - Bike Blvd. design has been approved and is out for bid. Should get bid results back in two weeks and project may be done before the end of 2017.

- Sidewalk along north side of Clark Lane between Paris and Highway 63 is waiting for final approval by MoDOT.
- Shepard to Rollins Trail connection is in preliminary design. There is some concern by residents and staff is justifying project with FHWA.

C. GetAbout/Parks and Rec - Godon

- IP meeting 5-6pm at MLK trail access on September 21 to replace bridges 5, 7, 8. New trail closure date to begin the project is Monday, November 27.

- A. Simonson discussed the possibility of the commission giving input on transportation / road / trail / sidewalk / traffic calming projects before they go into design i.e. become part of the City's IP process.
- B. Patrie asked for nominations for Vice Chair before next meeting.
- C. Gortmaker expressed concern for the slickness of newly painted crosswalks.
- D. Godon expressed concern about people driving not allowing people to clear the crosswalk before they enter the crosswalk.
