ROBBERY AT LANDMARK BANK

Columbia Police officers responded to 10 N. Garth Avenue, Landmark Bank, today at 3:00 p.m. in reference to a hold-up/ panic alarm.

Upon officers arrival they confirmed a robbery had occurred. The preliminary investigation revealed a male suspect entered the business, approached a teller, and demanded money. The suspect retrieved an undisclosed amount of money before fleeing the area on foot.

As more officers arrived on scene, they located a subject in the area that matched the description of the suspect. Officers made contact with the subject and after brief conversation the subject fled on foot. A short pursuit ensued and the subject was eventually detained in the 200 block of Bryant Street. The subject was transported to the Columbia Police Department for questioning. **The subject was determined to not be involved in the bank robbery.** At this time the suspect is still at large.

The suspect is described as a light skinned black male, approximately 5'6"-5'9" tall with a medium build and a goatee. He was last seen wearing dark colored clothing.
