## RESIDENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT PERMIT CONDITIONS PER CITY OF COLUMBIA CODE OF ORDINANCES 14-313:

## LIMITATIONS OF PERMIT

The permit is valid on streets with parking restrictions identified by Residential Permit Parking signs within the area as defined by the ordinance. The permit shall neither guarantee nor reserve a specific parking space to the holder.

The permit is also valid on streets signed Parking by Residential Parking Permit Only (PBRPPO). On streets signed PBRPPO, <u>only</u> permit holders may park in the designated unmetered spaces. If a permit holder parks at a metered space, the permit holder must pay any meter fees.

A permit does not authorize parking a motor vehicle or letting it stand when or where the stopping, standing, or parking of motor vehicles is prohibited or set aside for specified types of vehicles, nor does it exempt the holder from observing any traffic regulation or parking regulation.

## PERMIT IS VALID ONLY FOR ADDRESS, VEHICLE AND LICENSE PLATE FOR WHICH THE PERMIT WAS ISSUED

<u>PARKING METER REGULATIONS</u>: Residential parking permits are not valid at any parking meters. Parking meter fees and time limitations are in effect regardless of whether or not the parked vehicle has a residential parking permit displayed.

TRANSFER TO ANOTHER VEHICLE PROHIBITED: A permit is to be displayed **only** on the vehicle described on the *Application for Residential District Parking Permit* form. Transfer of a permit to a vehicle other than that described on this form is illegal.

IF YOU MOVE TO ANOTHER ADDRESS, CHANGE VEHICLES, CHANGE LICENSE PLATES ON YOUR VEHICLE, SELL OR JUNK YOUR VEHICLE, OR NEED A REPLACEMENT FOR ANY REASON: The permit may not be transferred, and you must get a replacement permit to remain in the residential parking district program. The original permit (all or part of it) must be removed from the vehicle and returned to the City of Columbia Public Works Department at the time you request a replacement permit.

If you move to an address outside the residential permit program area, you must return the permit to the City of Columbia Public Works Department, 701 E. Broadway, PO Box 6015, Columbia, MO 65205. Be sure to include your name and license plate number with your permit.

## **VIOLATIONS:**

- 1. No person shall park a motor vehicle in an unmetered space on a street within a residential parking district without a valid permit properly displayed.
- No person shall furnish false information in an application for a permit.
- 3. No person shall use or display or allow the use or display of a valid residential parking permit on a motor vehicle other than that for which the permit was issued.
- 4. No person shall use or display a facsimile or counterfeit permit.
- 5. No person shall sell, give or otherwise dispose of a vehicle displaying a permit without destroying that permit, and no subsequent owner of the vehicle shall use a permit issued to a previous owner.
- 6. No person shall allow a nonresident of a parking district to use or display a residential parking permit.
- 7. No person shall knowingly permit any act prohibited under this section, or aid or abet another to do so.
- 8. Each hour that a violation of this section continues is a separate offense.

THE PARKING PERMIT SHALL BE DISPLAYED IN THE FRONT WINDOW OF ALL VEHICLES IN THE UPPER RIGHT CORNER OF THE PASSENGER SIDE; OR ON MOTORCYCLES OR MOTOR SCOOTERS ON THE REAR FENDER OR WHEEL GUARD.
