EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing an appropriation of \$25,000 from Parking Utility Retained Earnings to pay for fiber optic connection to the 8th & Cherry parking garage in conjunction with the Finance department's move across the street from the parking garage. The installation of the fiber optics has enabled the garage security cameras to be connected to the City's LAN. Although these funds were appropriated last fiscal year for this purpose, the invoice for the installation was only recently received and, therefore, the appropriation will need to be recorded this fiscal year in order to process payment for the work.

DISCUSSION

When the City entered into a lease agreement for some of the Finance Department to move to the basement of the Bank of America Building at 800 Cherry Street, it was necessary to run a fiber optic connection to the facility to connect the Finance Department to the city network. This fiber optic installation provided the opportunity to connect the 8th and Cherry parking garage to the network. The attached ordinance appropriates \$25,000 for the Parking Utility's share of this project.
