RE: First Night 2007 New Year's Eve Agreement

SUMMARY: The City's Fiscal Year 2007 budget contains an appropriation of \$9,000 for the City's First Night Columbia 2007 New Year's Eve event which will be held on December 31, 2006. This resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into a formal agreement with First Night Inc., on behalf of the City, to conduct this event, provides for the dispersion of funds, and authorizes City services to support the event within budgetary constraints.

DISCUSSION: First Night Columbia is a public New Year's Eve event held in the downtown Columbia area and Stephens College which is open to all residents of the City. This event provides citizens of all ages an alcohol-free alternative to celebrate the coming of the New Year. The event is planned and operated by First Night, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation.

The Council included an appropriation of \$9,000 in the FY07 budget to help fund this event. As in the past, support services from several City Departments have been requested to assist with this event. This resolution authorizes the formal agreement between First Night, Inc. and the City, specifies how the City funds are to be spent, provides for dispersion of the funds to First Night, Inc. and authorizes the use of City resources to help support the event.

<u>Suggested Council Action:</u> Approve the resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into the agreement with First Night, Inc. for the purposes of staging First Night Columbia 2007.
