RE: Donation Appropriations - Memorial/Heritage Program & Stephens Lake Park

**Summary:** The Department of Parks and Recreation is requesting Council action to appropriate \$22, 750 in donated funds to the appropriate accounts for expenditure. The funds have been donated by various individuals and organizations for Memorial/Heritage Tree and Bench Program and for the development of Stephens Lake Park.

## Discussion:

Various groups and individuals have donated funds to purchase Memorial/Heritage trees and benches and to assist in the development of Stephens Lake Park.
