AN ORDINANCE

Starting at the NE comer of said Lot 15, thence along the north side of said lot, N81°44'40"W, 15.50 feet; thence S08°15'20"W, 160.00 feet to the Beginning of this centerline description; thence S51°45'35"W 70.00 feet to the end of the centerline description and containing 0.03 acres.
