Re: Report: Street Closure Requests

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City Manager's Office has received four street closure requests.

DISCUSSION:

Richard King has requested the closure of Ninth Street, from Walnut to Broadway, from 8am until midnight, on August 30th for a Summerfest event. He is also requesting a waiver of the open container from 6pm until midnight for this event.

Steve Johnson, Missouri River Bluffs Association, has requested the closure of Fourth Street, south of Cherry to the Flat Branch Brewery Entrance, on September 7th, from noon until 10pm, for a Taste of Local Missouri event. He is also requesting the sale of alcohol in the park from 3 p.m. until 7 p.m.

Joe Duncan, Columbia Track Club, has requested the closure of Broadway between 7th and 8th streets, on September 2nd, from 8am until 12:30pm, for the annual Heart of America Marathon.

Don Love has requested the closure of Cherry St., between Fourth and Fifth, and Fourth between Cherry and Flat Branch Brewery entrance, on August 18, from 8am until 11pm, for the annual PrideFest event.

The Special Event Committee has reviewed and approved these request contingent upon applicants providing certificate of liability insurance. The CID has reviewed and approved these four requests.






SECTION 24-71. REQUIRED; APPLICATION; CONDITIONS FOR ISSUANCE.

- (a) Whenever any person shall desire to temporarily block a portion of any public street or sidewalk for any purpose other than the collection of signatures on a petition or the dissemination of information, and whether or not such use shall require the closure of such street or sidewalk, such person shall make application on a form to be supplied by the city to the City Manager not less than ne (10) days prior to the next City Council meeting preceding the date the person shall desire to use such street or sidewalk. The City Manager may issue a permit to such person to use a portion of such street or sidewalk to such extent and for such time as the City Manager shall find to be reasonable necessary, provided that the City Manager shall find that the following conditions exist:
 - (1) No safety hazard will be created as determined by the director of public works or his designate, and
 - (1) No obstruction will be created that would unreasonably interfere with police, fire or health protection of the city, and
 - (1) No unreasonable interference with the normal uses of the abutting property will be created.
- (a) The person making an application to the City Manager shall, as a part of the application, present evidence that all users or owners or occupants of property abutting the area to be used have been notified of the use, the dates and time of such use and their right to protest under this section.

Sec. 24-72. Appeals; hearings before Council.

- 1. Any person aggrieved by a denial of a permit by the City Manager may file an appeal within five (5) days following such denial with the City Council to be acted upon at the next regular Council meeting after said appeal is filed. The City Council shall use the standards set out in section 24-71 in making its determination whether to uphold or reverse the City Manager's denial of the permit.
- 1. Any user, occupant or owner of property within the same general area of, or abutting the portion of the street or sidewalk to be used may either file a written protest or appeal before the City Council to register such a protest, and the City Council shall also consider such protest in making its determination whether to uphold or reverse the City Manager.

Each application which shall request the closure of a street or sidewalk in the downtown area of the city shall be referred to the City Council for action thereon. For purposes of this provision, the downtown area of the city shall be defined as an area bounded on the north by Park Avenue, on the east by College Avenue, on the south by Elm Street, and on the west by Providence Road. The Council shall use the standards set forth in section 24-71 in its consideration of such request.

We are sorry for any inconvenience and damage from last year. We had hoped assurances of additional safeguards reported to you by Matt Itswan had made the street closure acceptable.

A power outage resulted in the performance going later than we planned last year, but it still was over before the city deadline, and we believe the sound was well within city limits. We plan to have the outside entertainment over by 9 pm this year.

Matt has two off-duty officers lined up to keep an eye on things during the evening.

We can take extra steps to protect landscaping. People with booths on Cherry last year used the sidewalk but I wasn't aware of any blocking. We can make sure that doesn't happen again.

PrideFest is the major opportunity the LGBT community has to express its pride in the contributions it makes to Columbia's diverse opportunities, and to thank Columbia for support. And it is the major opportunity churches, government offices, businesses, professionals, civic groups, MU and so on have to express their commitment to ending discrimination.

We can have the interfaith service, music and other entertainment without closing Cherry Street, but this is the site that works best for booths by these groups.





SECTION 24-71. REQUIRED; APPLICATION; CONDITIONS FOR ISSUANCE.

- Whenever any person shall desire to temporarily block a portion of any public street or sidewalk for any purpose other than the collection of signatures on a petition or the dissemination of information, and whether or not such use shall require the closure of such street or sidewalk, such person shall make application on a form to be supplied by the city to the City Manager not less than ne (10) days prior to the next City Council meeting preceding the date the person shall desire to use such street or sidewalk.
