

Re: Fixing 2013 Property Tax Rate

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A resolution setting a public hearing and an ordinance which would set the 2013 property tax rate for the City of Columbia at \$041.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Columbia levies property taxes to support operations of basic services in the General Fund. The 2012 property tax supports the City's 2013 budget. These property taxes comprise approximately 9% of total General Fund revenue. The FY 2014 budget submitted to Council does **not** include a property tax rate increase. The 2013 property tax rate would remain at the low rate of \$0.41 (per \$100 assessed valuation). This rate is slightly below the maximum rate of \$0.4163 certified by the State Auditor's Office for 2012. The city has not yet received the certification for 2013.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City collected approximately \$7 million in property taxes in FY2013.
