The regular monthly meeting of the Citizens Police Review Board was held on Wednesday, July 10, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber. Dr. Martin, Chair, opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

The draft minutes of the May 22, 2013 Ordinance Review Subcommittee meeting and the June 12, 2013 regular meeting were distributed in advance of the meeting and both were approved as submitted.

Dr. Alexander and Mr. Sheltmire met with new recruits for the Columbia Police Department. Mr. Sheltmire felt it was a very positive experience overall. Ms. Wilson will meet with the next group of new recruits in August.

Mr. Sheltmire is continuing to work with an individual on updating the Spanish brochure for the CPRB.

Mr. Dowis met with Council member Trapp and discussed the mediation position.

Rose Wibbenmeyer discussed the status of revisions to the CPRB ordinance.

Mr. Dowis made a motion that once the Board agrees on the ordinance language, it will be presented to the police for review with the understanding that two (2) months from that time, it will be submitted to City Council. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sheltmire and passed unanimously.

Mr. Sheltmire made a motion to approve the survey being sent out to those who have participated in the CPRB process in the past. Dr. Kennett seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Members of the public commented.

Mr. Dowis commented on the revision and/or implementation of complaint investigation form(s) the Columbia Police Department uses to make it easier to review information.

Mr. Dowis moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Kennett and passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
