BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Trittenbach Development to temporarily close a portion of a sidewalk located on the south side of Walnut Street, between Short Street and College Avenue, as shown on "Exhibit A," from November 7, 2013 to August 1, 2014 to allow for the construction of a new apartment building at 1222 East Walnut Street. Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, closure of the sidewalk beginning on November 7, 2013 is contingent upon the opening of Short Street.

SECTION 2. Trittenbach Development shall close the sidewalk only in accordance with the sidewalk closure plan submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying Trittenbach Development, in writing, of such requirements. Trittenbach Development shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the sidewalk and street due to any damage caused by the construction activity. Trittenbach Development shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. Trittenbach Development shall proceed with construction activities which require the sidewalk closure without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the sidewalk closure permit by the City Council.


