Re: Donna Marsh - voluntary annexation (Case 13-207)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A request by Donna Marsh (owner) to annex approximately 0.92 acres of land into the City of Columbia, and to assign R-1 (One-Family Dwelling District) as permanent City zoning. The subject site is located on the east side of Creasy Springs Road, approximately 850 feet north of W. Prairie Lane, and is addressed 3680 N. Creasy Springs Road. (Case # 13-207)

DISCUSSION:

The applicant is proposing to annex approximately 0.92 acres of land into the city. The subject site is contiguous with the city limits to the east, and the applicant is requesting R-1 (One-Family Dwelling District) as permanent City zoning. The property is presently zoned Boone County R-S (Single-family Residential).

The site is occupied by one (1) single-family dwelling and accessory structures. Annexation is desired to allow for connection to the City's public sewer. Currently the site has an on-site septic tank. The property receives public water from Consolidated Public Water Supply District #1, electricity from Boone Electric Cooperative, and fire protection from the Boone County Fire Protection District. Upon annexation the property would be served by City sewer, and the Columbia Fire Department would assume fire protection duties per the territorial agreement.

The Planning and Zoning Commission will make a recommendation to the City Council on the permanent zoning request at its November 21, 2013 meeting.

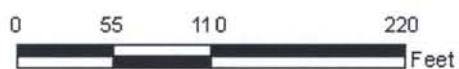
