Re: Adopt-A-Spot Beautification Agreements

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Volunteer Programs is submitting for approval four Adopt-A-Spot Beautification agreements to allow volunteers to care for landscaping in street right of way.

DISCUSSION:

Volunteers maintain more than 90 landscaped beds in city or state right of way in the City of Columbia. Adopters are responsible for weeding, watering, and mulching the beds and planting annual flowers and bulbs. Agreements are written for a four-year commitment and each bed has a sign to acknowledge the efforts of the adopter.

Staff is submitting four agreements for approval. All four are existing beds that have been relinquished by previous adopters.

- Dean Marth will be caring for a bed located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Broadway and Park de Ville. Mr. Marth has started to work on this bed in preparation of the 2014 growing season.
- Mizzou Athletics External Operations would like to adopt two small beds with established plantings at the corner of Nifona and Forum.
- Dogs Deserve Better will be adopting a bed in the median of Blue Ridge Road east of Providence.
- AmVets Post 182 has applied to adopt the median bed in Paris Road south of US 63. This fall Volunteer Programs worked with a group of volunteers from the MU Homecoming Day of Service to weed and remulch this bed.

The City's Volunteer Programs staff appreciates the investment that volunteers put into Adopt-A-Spot beds to be enjoyed by hundreds of residents and visitors each day.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will assist with ongoing support by providing mulch, bulbs, annual flowers, and replacement plants as needed. The City will pay for a sign to acknowledge the work of each adopter at a cost of \$130 per sign. Labor, which is the largest expense in maintaining the beds, will be provided by adopter.
